What is Warrior PATHH?

Warrior PATHH provides the training to transform struggle into strength in the aftermath of trauma. Warrior PATHH (Progressive and Alternative Training for Helping Heroes) is based on the science of Posttraumatic Growth (PTG). It is a 90-day, non-pharmacological, peer-delivered training program that begins with a 7-day intensive and immersive initiation. This is followed by three months of dedicated support, training, accountability, and connection from a team of trained combat veterans.
