

National AGC Safety Awards (NASA)

FAQs

1. Who is eligible to participate in the NASA program?

The NASA program is open exclusively to AGC member companies.

2. How can I enter the NASA program?

To enter the NASA program, an AGC chapter must submit your entry on your behalf. AGC chapters will reach out to member companies annually to announce the application process. At the beginning of each year, chapters will request summary data from your OSHA 300A log for the previous year. There is no application fee for participation.

3. What are the criteria for winning an award?

Awards are given based on the following criteria:

- **Zero-Incident Rate**: A Certificate of Commendation is awarded to members with a zero-incident rate.
- Incidence Rate Below 25 Percent of Division Rate: A Certificate of Commendation is awarded to members whose incidence rate is 25 percent below the average rate for their occupational division.

4. How are awards distributed?

All member awards are issued to AGC chapters, which are responsible for distributing them to the member companies.

5. What are the occupational divisions in the NASA program?

The NASA program evaluates safety records in the following occupational divisions:

- Building
- Highway
- Federal & Heavy
- Utility Infrastructure
- Associate/Specialty

6. My company performs work in different occupational divisions – how should I treat our data?

You can submit data for multiple divisions. However, please separate your safety data and work hours accordingly for each division.

7. Can I submit multiple entries in the same division?

No – multiple entries in the same division are not allowed.

8. My company is a member of multiple AGC chapters. Can I submit our 300A data to multiple chapters?

No – please submit your data to one chapter only.

9. My company performs work in multiple states. Should I submit our combined 300A data (for all states)?

If your company performs works in multiple states, please submit your combined 300A data. This data should be submitted to one chapter only.

10. My company has several branches across the country. Can each branch submit data separately?

No – you must consolidate data from all branches and submit to one chapter.
